Annual Events

National Convention: This is a Mizzou NSBE subsidized event that our members can attend. This year located in San Antonio, TX, the convention offers technical seminars, leadership training, a career fair, and networking events. Mizzou NSBE is always represented in large numbers, and many members obtain internships/co-ops and establish nationwide networks.

A Walk for Education: This is an annual NSBE community outreach event in which members walk door to door raising awareness about engineering with underprivileged children and parents in nearby neighborhoods. The children are invited to the neighborhood's community center where lunch is provided and engineering activities are conducted.

Fall Regional Conference: This is a regional event Mizzou NSBE sponsors members to attend. This year located in St. Louis, MO, the conference offers access to career and leadership development workshops, a career fair, networking socials, and technical seminars.
